

Terms and Conditions related to the tickets sold through GIORGIOSTUDIO Ltd's website

1. GIORGIOSTUDIO Ltd, hereafter named as "Event Promoter", is the official Promoter of the event named "**Negrity Live in London**", hereafter named as "The Event", to be held on Sunday 8th June 2008.
2. Tickets are sold subject to the venue or Event Promoter's right to alter or vary the programme due to events or circumstances beyond its reasonable control without being obliged to refund monies or exchange tickets.
3. The expenses for the tickets bought through our website depend on the number of tickets and the credit card used, and amount to a minimum of £5 (five pounds).
4. It is the customer's responsibility to ascertain whether The Event has been cancelled and the date and time of any rearranged event. If The Event is cancelled or rescheduled by the Event Promoter, the Event Promoter will use reasonable endeavours to notify ticket holders of the cancellation. The Event Promoter GIORGIOSTUDIO Ltd does not guarantee that ticket holders will be informed of such cancellation before the date of the event.
5. If The Event is cancelled, the Event Promoter will refund only £20 (twenty pounds) per ticket. No other charges or other expenses will be refunded by the Event Promoter. In case of cancellation, the customer's claim has to be sent to GIORGIOSTUDIO Ltd, PO Box 56222, London, N4 1UT; the customer must enclose his/her unused tickets and comply with any other reasonable instructions of the Event Promoter. For accounting purposes, the customers' unused tickets must be received by the Event Promoter within 28 days from the date of the cancelled performance. This does not affect your statutory rights. We regret that unless this paragraph 4 applies, tickets cannot be exchanged or refunded after purchase without the written approval by the Event Promoter.
6. If The Event is rescheduled, ticket holders will be offered seats at any rescheduled performance (subject to availability) up to £20 (twenty pounds) or, if the ticket holder is unable to attend the rescheduled performance or the performance is not rescheduled, a refund limited to £20 (twenty pounds) excluded any booking fee or other expenses.
7. The Event Promoter will not be responsible for any tickets that are lost or stolen.
8. Neither the venue, nor the Event Promoter, shall have any further liability beyond the sum paid for tickets, which does not include any booking fee or any other expenses.
9. All of these terms and conditions are governed by English Law and any disputes arising out of any transaction with either the Event Promoter are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.
